#### **Komisaun Anti-Korrupsi(CAC) hala’o semináriu iha loron 7 fulan-Dezemburu; Komemorasaun no tomada-de posse iha loron 9 fulan-Dezemburu**

Jornalistas sira hetan konvite ba atende eventus rua iha loron 7 no loron 9 fulan-Dezemburu 2010, ne’ebé Komisaun Anti-Korrupsi (CAC) organiza hodi komemora Loron Internasional Anti-Korrupsaun (9 Dezemburu). Journalists are invited to attend the following two events on 7 and 9 December, 2010, which the Anti-Corruption Commission (CAC) has organized to commemorate International Anti-Corruption Day (December 9).

#### **7 December 2010, National seminar, *Our Commitment to Fighting Corruption* Convention Centre (ex. Mercado Lama), 8.30am-5pm.**

This seminar has been organized in coordination with the Office of the President, the Office of the President of the National Parliament and the Office of Prime Minister.

“This seminar will mainly target public servants, the private sector and key state institutions,” said CAC Commissioner, Adérito de Jesus Soares.

“While CAC is responsible for investigating corruption, it is crucial to have the commitment of public servants and all these state institutions in order to prevent corruption,” said Commissioner Soares.

- **Opening** – Several prominent figures will address the opening session including the CAC Commissioner; Bishop Alberto Ricardo (Dili Diocese); Prime Minister H.E. Xanana Gusmao; and Deputy SRSR, Finn Reske-Nielsen. The seminar will be formally opened by the President of the National Parliament, H.E. Fernando Lasama de Araujo.

- **Session 1** – H.E. Marie Alkatiri (Former Prime Minister) and Vicente Guterres (Vice President of the National Parliament) will address the first session, *Integrity of the state under the rule of law*.
- **Session 2** – H.E. Prime Minister Xanana Gusmao will address the following session *The effective management of state resources*.
- **Session 3** – Commissioner Soares and Prosecutor General, Ana Pessoa will address the third session *The implementation of the UN Convention Against Corruption (UNCAC) in Timor-Leste*.
  - **Sessions 1-3 followed by panel discussion** – Sessions 1-3 will be followed by a panel discussion. Panelists include Brigadier General Lere Annan Timur (F-FDTL); PNTL Commissioner Longuinhos Monteiro; Provedor Sebastiao Ximenes; Dr Benjamin Corte Real, National University; Minister of Finance Emilia Pires; Minister of Justice Lucia Lobato; CAC Deputy Commissioner, Manuel Bucar; private sector representative; head of NGO Forum; World Bank representative; and a representative of the media.
- **Closing** – This seminar will close with a reflection by Fr Joao Aparicio, SDB; and a summary presentation by CAC Deputy Commissioner, Jose Neves.

### **9 December Commemoration of International Anti-Corruption Day; and swearing-in for CAC staff and investigators**

On 9 December, 2010, International Anti-Corruption Day, CAC will host a swearing-in ceremony for 9 staff, 9 investigators and 3 directors at the Community Centre in Maubara from 9am -12 noon.

- Swearing-in by CAC Commissioner, 9am -12 noon – with President of the National Parliament, H.E. Mr. Fernando Lasama de Araujo and Deputy SRSR, Finn Reske-Nielsen 9am -12 noon
- Community dialogue with Maubara residents with CAC Commissioner and Deputy Commissioners; Prosecutor General, Anna Pessoa; Inspector General, Francisco Carvalho; Provedor Sebastiao Ximenes; and President of the Public Service Commission Liborio Pereira.
